



## **MANHATTAN/QUEENS IN-HOME BEHAVIOR MANAGEMENT**

Lifespire provides in-home behavior management training to families of OPWDD-eligible individuals. Typical areas covered include principles of positive behavior supports, applied behavior analysis, and behavior plan implementation. The service is provided by a master's-level behavioral intervention specialist.

- *The service is free!*
- *Medicaid is not required.*
- *Weekly in-home visits arranged at family's convenience.*
- *No age requirements!*
- *Available in Russian for residents of Queens.*

# **92Y NESHER PROGRAMS**

for Children with Developmental Disabilities

The Neshet afterschool program provides recreation based programs for 7-14 year olds with special needs, including neurological impairment, cognitive delays, speech and language delays, learning disabilities, PDD, Asperger syndrome and Autism.

Neshet strengthens and supports the social development and learning experiences and fosters social skills, fine and gross motor coordination, communication, language and academic skills

The staff includes teachers, specialists and teaching artists, with a 1 to 4 staff to child ratio.

### **Program Schedule**

3 pm: Children arrive at 92Y, are met by afterschool staff and escorted to clubhouse, which is a nurturing environment for children to transition after a full day at school, while socializing with Neshet friends and enjoying a light snack

3:30-5 pm: 92Y Neshet Classes

5-5:45 pm: Extended Day available for an additional fee of \$225 per day for the year

### **Afterschool Transportation to 92Y**

Children are bussed from their school by the Office of Pupil Transportation. Parents make these arrangements directly with the Office of Pupil Transportation to be dropped off after school, and parents pick children up at 5 pm, when classes end.
